Call for Papers

The ninth conference of the International Joseph A. Schumpeter Society will take place in Gainesville, Florida/USA from March 28 to March 30, 2002. The general theme of the conference is:

### **Entrepreneurship, the New Economy and Public Policy: Schumpeterian Perspectives**

The scientific committee of the congress would like to encourage you to submit papers

devoted to theoretical, empirical and historical aspects of Schumpeterian economics.

Abstracts should be written in English. Each abstract should be at least one half page and less than two pages long, and should include an E-mail address and a fax address of the corresponding author.

Electronic submission (use Word, WordPerfect, or pdf format) of abstracts is highly recommended. Submit an abstract to one of the E-mail addresses below with a copy (cc) to the other.

Abstracts must be received before **December 10, 2001**.

## 8th ISS Schumpeter Prize Competition 2002

The International Joseph Alois Schumpeter Society, ISS, is pleased to announce its 8th Schumpeter Prize Competition. The prize is awarded every two years in recognition of a recent scholarly contribution related to Schumpeter's work. It carries a cash award of 10,000 EURO endowed by the German economics and business weekly, *Wirtschaftswoche*.

### **Entrepreneurship, the New Economy and Public Policy: Schumpeterian Perspectives**

has been designated by the managing board of the society as the topic for the eighth competition.

Entries must be postmarked no later than **December 31, 2001**. Works submitted must be either unpublished or published subsequent to June 1, 2000. Submissions may be of article or book length. There is no page or format specification. Submissions will be judged by a committee

appointed in 2000 at the biennial meeting of the ISS.

The winner will be announced and the award made at the congress of the society in the University of Florida, Gainesville, Florida, USA, March 28-30, 2002.
